

United States to Carrie Poor
 Certificate No. 3708.

The United States of America, To All
 to Whom these Presents shall Come, Greet-
 ing:

Whereas, Carrie Poor, of Skamania County,
 Washington, has deposited in the General
 Land Office of the United States a Certifi-
 cate of the Register of the Land Office
 at Vancouver, Washington, whereby it
 appears that full payment has been made
 by said Carrie Poor according to the
 provisions of the Act of Congress of the
 7th of April, 1870, entitled "An Act
 making further provision for the sale
 of the Public Lands," and the acts sup-
 plemental thereto, for the South east quar-
 ter of the South east quarter of Sec-
 tion Seven in Township two North of
 Range Six East of Willamette Me-
 ridian in Washington, containing
 forty acres, according to the official
 plat of the survey of the said Lands,
 returned to the General Land Office
 by the Surveyor General, which said
 tract has been purchased by the
 said Carrie Poor.

Now Know Ye, That the United
 States of America, in consideration
 of the premises, and in conform-
 ity with the several acts of Con-
 gress in such cases made and
 provided, have given and granted,
 and by these presents do give and
 grant, unto the said Carrie Poor
 and to her heirs, the said tract
 above described; To Have and to
 Hold the same, together with

all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Carrie Poor and to her heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In Testimony Whereof I, Grover Cleveland, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the twenty-sixth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twentieth.
