To all to whom these presents shall come. Greeting:

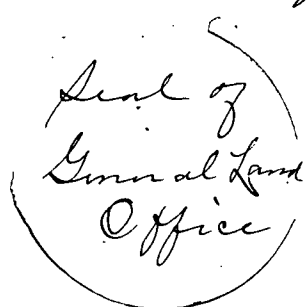
} Whereas There has
been deposited in the General Land Office
of the United States a Certificate of the Register
of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington whereby
it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress
approved 20th May 1862 "To Secure Homesteads to
actual settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts
supplemental thereto the claim of Frederick R. Hammett
has been established and duly consummated
in conformity to law for the North half of the
North East quarter and the East half of the North
west quarter of Section Thirty-four in Township two
North of Range four East of Willamette Meridian
in Washington, containing one hundred and
sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of
the Survey of the said Land and returned to the
General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted
by the United States unto the said Frederick R. Hammett
the tract of Land above described: To Have and
to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenan-
ces thereof unto the said Frederick R. Hammett and to
his heirs and assigns forever: subject to any
pre-
existing and accrued water rights for mining,
agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes,
and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in con-
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nection with such water rights as may be recognized
and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and
decision of courts, and also subject to the right of the
proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove
his ore therefrom, should the same be found to

punctate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In Testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twenty-second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety six and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty-first.
