

The United States to William Kennedy
 The United States of America
 Certificate No. 5165 To all to whom these presents shall
 come Greeting:

Whereas William Kennedy of
 Stromanica County Washington has deposited in
 the General Land Office of the United States a
 Certificate of the Register of the Land Office
 at Vancouver Washington whereby it appears
 that full payment has been made by the said
 William Kennedy according to the provisions
 of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820
 entitled, "An Act making further provision for the
 sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplē-
 -mental thereto for the Lot numbered four of
 Section thirty-four in Township three North of
 Range nine East of Willamette Meridian in
 Washington Containing ten acres and thirty five
 hundredths of an acre according to the Official
 Plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to
 the General Land Office by the Surveyor General
 which said tract has been purchased by the said
 William Kennedy.

Now know YE, That the United
 States of America in Consideration of the premises,
 and in Conformity with the several Acts of
 Congress in such Case made and provided, have
 given and granted, and by these presents do give
 and grant unto the said William Kennedy
 and to his heirs, the said tract above described;

To have and to hold the same together with
 all the rights, privileges ~~and~~ immunities and
 appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto
 belonging unto the said William Kennedy and
 to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any water
 and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural
 manufacturing or other purposes and rights to
 ditches and reservoirs used in connection with

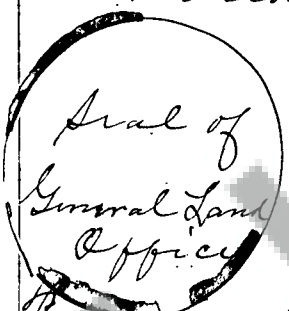
such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right-of-way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In Testimony whereof J. William McKinley President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twenty-fifth day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty second
