To the County Commissioners

We the undersigned legal Petitioners of the aforesaid County do ask your Honorable body to form a new voting district to be known as the Bare Prairie Precinct and to appoint a Board of inspectors for said District to superintend and inspect the Polls of Election so to take effect that they shall hold their first election at the same time of the First General Election of the State of Washington which is to be held in October A.D. 1889.

The Bounderies of said district to be as follows.

On the West by the County Line as far south as the Washougal to the mouth of the North Washougal thence up the north Washougal in a Northeast course to the North boundary of Section (20) Thence East on section lines to the main or big Washougal Thence up the big Washougal to the north boundary line of Government Survey. Thence West on said survey to a line. Thence south to place of starting. Dated this March 13th 1889.
