LOCATION OF MINE.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having Complied with the requirements of chapter six Title 32 of the revised statute of the United States have located 1500 lineal feet in the Monarch lode situated in the Washougal Mining District in Skamania County, Washington Territory, Described as follows.
