Notice Miner's Location E. Parrott.

Notice is hereby given, that I the undersigned citizens of the United States claim 1500 feet linear measure, on this lode or vein of gold and silver bearing quartz. Commencing at this notice and monument, and running Westerly therefrom along the line of the lode a distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked West end center stake, and Easterly along the line of said lode a distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked South end center stake with the dips and spurs and angles of said lode, together with the surface ground on each side of said lode, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:
