To all to whom these Presents shall Come Greeting:

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Michael Leon has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the West half of the North East quarter and the West half of the South East quarter of section seven in Township two North of Range five East of Willamette Meridian in Washington containing one hundred and sixty acres. according to the official plat of the survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now known &c. That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Michael Leon the tract of Land above described

To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Michael Leon and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and deemed water rights for mining, agricultural or manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a mine or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom

should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In Testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
