To all whom these Presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Washington Washington D. C. showing it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain" and the Acts supplemental thereto the Claim of Ernest H. Prindle has been established and duly confirmed in Conformity to law for the North West quarter of the South West quarter, the South half of the South West quarter and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section One in Township One or north of Range Two East of the Main and the Meridian in Washington Containing One hundred and sixty acres. according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Ernest H. Prindle the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto unto the said Ernest H. Prindle and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining agricultural manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognised and acknowledged by the local

Customs laws and decisions of Courts and
also subject to the right of the proprietor of a
mine or land to extract and remove his ore
Therefrom should the same be found to penetrate
or intersect the premises hereby granted as pro-
vided by law. And there is reserved from the
lands hereby granted a right of way thereon
for ditches or canals constructed by the
Authority of the United States.
