

Location of Mines.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the U. S. over the age of twenty-one years on the 20th day of May 1889 discovered a vein or lode of quartz in place bearing gold, silver and lead with in the limits of the claim hereby located and have this 19th day of June 1889 under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the U.
