Whereas, Thomas Miller of Skamania County Washington has deposited in The General Land Office of The United States a Certificate of The Register of The Land Office at Vancouver Washington, whereby it appears that that full Payment has been made by The said Thomas Miller according to The provisions of The act of Congress of The 24th April 1820, Entitled "An Act Making further provisions for The sale of The Public Lands," and The acts Supplemental Thereto, for The Lots numbered one and two, and The East half of The North West quarter of Section nineteen in Township Three North of Range six East of The Wacarcum Meridian in Washington Containing one Hundred and fifty out acres and seventy five Hundredths of an acre according to The Official Plat of The Survey of The said Lands returned to The General Land Office by The Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by The said Thomas Miller

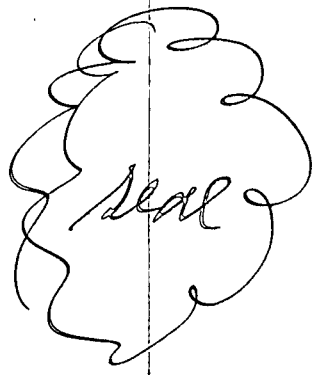
Now Know Ye, That The United States of America in Consideration of The premises, and in Conformity with The several acts of Congress in such Cases made, and provided, have given and granted and by These presents do give and grant unto The said Thomas Miller and to his heirs, The said tract above described; To have and to hold together with all The privileges, immunities, and Appurtenances of Whatsoever Nature Thereunto belonging, unto The said Thomas Miller and to his heirs and assigns forever; Subject to any vested and accrued water rights for Mining, agricultural, Manufacturing or other purposes, and The rights to ditches ^{and} reservoirs used in Connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by The local Customs, laws, and decisions of Courts and also Subject to The right of The proprietor of a vein or lode to Extract and remove his ore therefrom, Should The same be found to penetrate or intersect The premises ^{granted} hereby as provided by law; And There is reserved from The lands hereby granted, a right of Way Thereon for ditches and Canals Constructed by authority of The United States
