This Indenture made by and between B B Bishop of Wasco County Territory of Oregon of the first part and Daniel Baughman of Skamania County Territory of Washington of the second part witnesseth That the party of the first part bargains and sells and quit claims to the party of the second part for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged- All that parcel or tract of land in the county of Skamania & Territory aforesaid known as the Baughman claim lying and being situated about one mile up the river from the town called Cascades- To have and to Hold all and singular the above mentioned and described premises forever- in witness whereof the said party of the first part have hereunto set his hand and seal this 28th day of January 1858

Know all men by these presents That I Simeon Geil of the county of Skamania and territory of Washington of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred dollars to me paid by Felix Grundy Iman of the county and territory aforesaid of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do grand and convey unto the said party of the second part, his executors administrators and assigns, all of my right title or ownership to or in a certain saw-mill in the county and territory aforesaid, about two miles from the upper cascades of the Columbia River at the third fall from the mouth of a stream called Rock Creek (my said ownership being the one half thereof) together with all the machinery and appurtenances to said mill belonging to have and to hold the said mill
