No 267 } Whereas, Felix L. Imans of Okanania
County, Washington Territory, has deposited in the
General Land Office of the United States a certificate
of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver where-
by it appears that full payment has been made by the
said Felix L. Imans according to the provisions of the act
of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act
making further provision for the sale of the public lands,"
for

the North East quarter of the North West quarter and the
Lots numbered Six, Seven, and Nine, of Section One, in Town-
ship Two, North of Range Seven, East, in the District of
lands subject to sale at Vancouver, Washington Territory,
containing Eighty six acres and Sixty one hundredths of
an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said
lands, returned to the General Land Office by the
Surveyor General, which said Tracts have been purchased
by the said Felix L. Imans

Now know ye, That the United States of America,
in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with
the several acts of Congress in such case made and provid-
ed, Have Given And Granted, and by these presents do
Give And Grant, unto the said Felix L. Imans and
to his heirs, the said Tracts above described: To Have
and to Hold the same, together with all the rights,
privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever
nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Felix L.
Imans

In Testimony whereof, I Andrew Johnson, Presi-
dent of the United States of America, have caused these
letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General
Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

one thousand eight hundred and Sixty six, and
of the Independence of The United States the
Seal of Ninetieth.
