

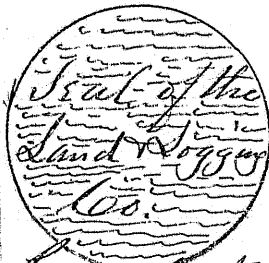
Lease - Julius Ordway to Washougal Logging Co.
 This Agreement between Julius
 Ordway of Portland, Oregon, and Wash-
 ougal Land and Logging Co. of L. Grams
 Washington: Witnesseth:

That the said Julius Ordway
 in consideration of the Covenants of said
 Washougal Land and Logging Co. herein
 mentioned, doth hereby lease unto the said
 Washougal Land and Logging Co. their
 executors or administrators, from the
 31st day of May, in the year 1892 until
 the 31st day of May in the year 1897,
 the following described premises, to wit:

The exclusive right to use the Logging
 Camps, consisting of a house & cook
 shanty and summer quarters attached;
 a barn and sheds attached, and a
 blacksmith shop: better known as the "Ordway
 Logging Camps": Also the right to take
 water from a creek running to the cut and
 close to said Camps; and also the right
 to construct any buildings required, all
 being situated on the South West quarter
 (S. W. 1/4) of Section Thirteen (13) Township
 Two (2) North of Range Five (5) East of
 Willamette Meridian. And the said
 Washougal Land & Logging Co. doth hereby
 promise and agree to pay said Julius
 Ordway therefor the next following, to
 wit: One dollar per year, payable
 in advance; and to return said
 premises at the expiration of said
 time in as good order and condition
 as they are now in, reasonable wear

and bear, fire, and unavoidable casualties excepted.
