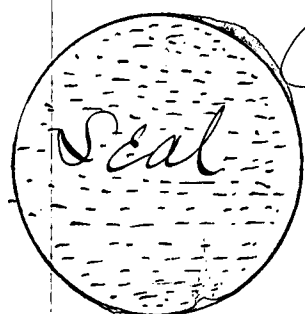


The United States to James Haffey
 Homestead Certificate No. 2402 The United States of America
 Application 7706 To all to whom these Presents shall
 come Greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in
 the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate
 of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Wash
 whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of
 Congress approved 20th May 1862 To secure Homesteads
 to actual Settlers on the Public Domain and the acts
 supplemental thereto the claim of James Haffey has
 been established and duly consummated in conformity
 to law for the North half of the North East quarter
 and the North half of the North West fractional quarter
 of Section five in Township one North of Range five
 East of Willamette Meridian in Washington containing
 one hundred and sixty ~~one~~ acres and eight hundredths
 of an acre according to the Official plat of the
 survey of the said Land returned to the General Land
 Office by the Surveyor General

Now know ye that there is therefore granted by
 the United States unto the said James Haffey the
 tract of land above described: To have and to hold
 the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof
 unto the said Haffey and to his heirs and assigns
 forever: subject to any vested and accrued water rights
 for mining agricultural manufacturing or other purp-
 oses and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection
 with such water rights as may be recognized and
 acknowledged by the local customs laws and decisions
 of courts and also subject to the right of the proprie-
 tor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore
 therefrom should the same be found to penetrate
 or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided
 by law. and there is reserved from the lands
 hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches
 or canals constructed by the Authority of the
 United States. In testimony whereof I Benjamin

Given under my hand at the City
of Washington the sixteenth day of May in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and ninety two; and of the Independence of
the United States the one hundred and sixteenth
