

MINER'S LOCATION. E. PARROT.

Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned citizen of the United States claim 1500 feet linear measure on this lode of gold and silver bearing quartz, Commencing at this notice and monument and running Westerly therefrom along the line of the lode a distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked West end center stake and Easterly along the line of said lode a distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked East end center stake with the dips, and spurs and angles of said lode together with the surrounding on each side of said lode bounded and described as follows to wit:
