Know all men by these presents, that the Cascades Rail Road Company a corporation organized under the laws of Washington, Territory, is held and firmly bound unto Samuel M Hamilton of the County of Skamania, in the sum of ten thousand dollars \$10,000 00/100 for the payment of which it hereby binds itself.

Sealed with its seal and dated July 27th 1863 The condition of this obligation, is such, that whereas, the said Cascade Rail Road, Company, has agreed, and does hereby agree to and with the said Samuel M Hamilton that from the commencement of the incline of its rail road, on the bank of the Columbia River in Skamania County 🗱 T. down to the lower terminus of said Rail Road, upon the land conveyed this day to said corporation by the Said Samuel M Hamilton and Mary J Hamilton his wife, the said corporation will not engage in the sale of any goods, wares, or merchandise, or set up any hotel, tavern, eating, or drinking house, or establishment or permit the same to be done upon or on the river in front, of said premises, except, by the said Samuel M Hamilton, or his grantees, and except such temporary sales as may occur, upon steamers, doing business, with said corporation. And has further agreed that the said Samuel/Hamilton, may move, anchor, or fasten, a warf boat, on the river, in front of said premises, now interfering with the business of said corporation in the landing of steamers, and in receiving, discharging and the transportation; of freight, and passengers, and that the said Samuel M. Hamilton, shall have the exclusive right of establishing a store for the sale of goods, wares, and merchandize, and for a hotel tavern, eating or drinking house, for public accommodation, upon said premises.
