

BOOK A RECORDS OF SKAMANIA COUNTY.

under the provisions of the act of Congress approved the 27th day of September 1850, entitled, An Act to create the office of Surveyor General of the Public Lands in Oregon, and to provide for the survey and to make donations to settlers of the said Public Lands: the claim of Daniel F Bradford, of Skamania County Washington Territory, Notification No 300 has been established, to a donation of One section, or six hundred and forty acres of land, and that the same has been surveyed and designated as Claim No 37 and as parts of Sections, 2, 11, 14, and 15 in Township Two North of Range Seven East in Washington Territory, according to the official Plat of Survey, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, being bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning on the Columbia River at the North East corner of this survey, thence North $54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ west 50 chains; thence South 29° West 55 chains: thence South 23° East 42 chains and 50 links: thence East 3 chains and 95 links; thence South 40° chains; thence West 27 chains and 50 links; thence South 43° East 42 Chains: Thence with the meanders of the Columbia, North 83° East 3 chains, North 67° East, 2 chains and 64 links: North $51\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ East 1 chain and 84 links North $43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East, 5 chains, and 76 links; North $50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East, 3 chains and 50 links: North 55° East, 4 chains, and 21 links: North $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 7 chains and 86 links: North 32° East, 6 chains and 50 links: North $41\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 3 chains and 89 links: North $38\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 9 chains and 39 links: North 27° East 2 chains and 38 links: North $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 5 chains and 80 links North $14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East, 2 chains and 35 links: North $36\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East, 4 chains and 50 links: North $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 12 chains and 10 links: North $9\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ west, 2 chains and 94 links: North 61° West, 1 chain and 46 links: North 17° west 5 chains and 26 links; North $36\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ west, 18 chains and 20 links: North 29° west, - 4 chains and 50 links: North 11° west 5 chains and 55 links: North $67\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 1 chain and 32 links: North $25\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ west 3 chains: North 56° west, 5 chains and 22 links: West, 4 chains and 8 links: North $16\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ East, 14 chains and 90 links: North 48° East 3 chains and 67 links: East 2 chains and 89 links North $50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East, 5 chains and 6 links: North 64° East 2 chains and 95 links: North $41\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East, 9 chains and 35 links, to the place of beginning: Containing six hundred and thirty nine acres and seventy eight-hundredths of an acre The right to the said tract as a Donation having been adjudged to the said Bradford and wife by a decision, dated November 28th 1862, of the Secretary of the Interior

Now know ye; That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the provisions of the act aforesaid Have given and Granted, and by these presents, Do give and Grant, unto the said Daniel F Bradford the South half, and to his wife Chloe H Bradford the North half of the tract of land above described:

To have and to hold the said tract, with the appurtenances, unto the said Daniel F Bradford, and his wife Chloe H. Bradford, and to their heirs and assigns forever; their respective portions as aforesaid

In testimony whereof I Abraham Lincoln, President of the United States, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
