

NOTICE OF LOCATION.

Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned citizen of the United States claim fifteen hundred feet linear measure on this lode of vein of gold or silver bearing quartz. Commencing at this notice and monument and running East therefrom along the line of the lode 15 feet to a stake marked West end stake and East along the line of said lode a distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked East end center stake with the dips, spurs and angles of said lode together with the surface ground on each side of said lode bounded and described as follows to wit:

Commencing at the stake last named and running South therefrom at right angles with the general direction of said lode three hundred feet to a stake marked S. East corner stake thence, at right angle West 750 feet to a stake marked S.
