

United States to Samuel Paisley

The United States of America
 Certificate No 3930; To all to whom these presents
 shall come Greeting; Whereas Samuel Paisley,
 of Multnomah County Oregon has deposited in the
 General Land Office, of the United States a Certificate
 of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver
 Washington whereby it appears, that full payment
 has been made by the said Samuel Paisley accord-
 ing to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the
 9th of April 1820, entitled, An act making further
 provision for the sale of the Public Lands, and the
 acts supplemental thereto for

The Lots numbered One and Two and the
 South Half of the North East quarter of Section two
 in Township two North of Range five East of Willamette
 Meridian in Washington containing One hundred and
 sixty one acres and ninety three hundredths of an
 acre. According to the Official Plat of the
 Survey of the said Lands returned to the General
 Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said
 Tract has been purchased by the said Samuel
 Paisley.

Now know ye, that the United States of America in
 consideration of the premises and in conformity
 with the several acts of Congress in such, case
 made and provided, Have given and granted, and by
 these presents do give and grant, unto the said
 Samuel Paisley and to his heirs, the said tract above
 described; To have and to hold the same, together
 with all the rights privileges immunities, and
 appurtenances, of what-soever nature, therunto belonging
 unto the said Samuel Paisley and to his heirs and
 assigns forever subject to any vested and accrued
 water rights for mining, agricultural manufacturing
 or other purposes, and rights to ditches and ror-
 voirs used in connection with such water rights
 as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local,

customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted and provided by law: and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In Testimony Whereof J. Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office, to be hereunto affixed.
