This Memorandum of agreement made
Oct-5-th 1893 by and between the Rowe
Lumber & Mfg Co party of the first part
and Wm Green Party of the Second part
& wit: I Wm Green do hereby agree to
make out and deliver to the party of
the first part a Warranty Deed within
30 days of this date of two and one half
acres of land it been more fully described
as follows Commencing at the N.E. Corner
of the fractional quarter in Section 32
Township 3 N Range 8 East thence running
west on said North line of said fraction
until two and one half acres of land is
contained between this line and the River thence
south to the Columbia River thence east along
the north bank of said Columbia River to the
east line of said fraction thence north to
the place of Beginning containing 2 1/2
acres also I hereby Grant the right
or privilege to the first parties their
heirs or assigns to use for booming
purposes on the south side of the remaining
fraction said fraction containing about
17 seventeen acres granting them the
right to make fast Booms and piling to
make the Bay Eddy or Slough in front of said
fraction suitable for logging and booming
purposes all for the sum of One Hundred
dollars, five dollars of which paid to me in
hand

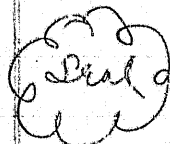
