To have and to hold the same unto the said Putnam F. Bradford, and his heirs, forever, together with all the rights, franchius, and appurtenances thereunto belonging and appertaining, with all the improvements thereon, giving unto the said Putnam F Bradford, peacable possession of the same, and covenanting for ourselves, and heirs, not to disturb him in the peaceable, and quiet enjoyment of the same.
