To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:  
 Whereas, there has been deposited in the General  
 Land Office of the United States a certificate of the  
 Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington  
 whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Con-  
 gress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads  
 to actual Settlers on the Public Domain" and the  
 acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Thomas H.  
 Monaghan has been established and duly consummated  
 in conformity to law, for the,

Lots numbered six and, seven, the North West-  
 quarter of the North East-quarter, and the South  
 half of the South East-quarter of Section twenty-  
 eight in Township three North of Range eight East  
 of Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory  
 containing One hundred and fifty three acres  
 and twenty five hundredths of an acre.


According to the Official Plat of the Survey  
 of the said land, returned to the General Land  
 Office by the surveyor General:

Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted  
 by the United States unto the said Thomas H. Monaghan,  
 the tract of Land above described; To have and to  
 hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances  
 therof, unto the said Thomas H. Monaghan and to his  
 heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested  
 and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural  
 manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to  
 ditches and reservoirs used in connection with  
 such water rights, as may be recognized and  
 acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and de-  
 cisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of  
 the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and  
 remove his ore therefrom, should the same be

found to penetrate or intersect the premises  
hereby granted, as provided by law.

In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison  
President of the United States of America have  
caused these letters to be made Patent, and  
the seal of the General Land Office, to be  
affixed.
