To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting
Whereas Louis Wilhelm of Skamania County Wash-
ington, has deposited in the General Land Office
of the United States a Certificate of the register of
the land office at Vancouver Washington whereby it
appears full payment has been made by the said
Louis Wilhelm according to the provisions of the
act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820 entitled "An act
making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands
and the acts supplemental thereto, for.

The South West Quarter of Section twenty nine
in Township three North of Range six East of
Columbia Meridian in Washington containing
One hundred and sixty acres.

according to the official plat of the Survey of the
said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by
the Surveyor General, which said tract has been
purchased by the said Louis Wilhelm.

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in
consideration of the premises, and in conformity
with the several acts of Congress in such case made
and provided, have given and granted and by these
presents do give and grant, unto the said Louis
Wilhelm and to his heirs, the said tract above
described: To have and to hold, the same together with
all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurten-
ances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging
unto the said Louis Wilhelm and to his heirs
and assigns forever: subject to any vested and
accrued water rights for mining, agricultural
manufacturing, or other purpose, and rights to
ditches and reservoirs used in connection with
such water rights, as may be recognized and
acknowledged by the local customs, laws and
decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right

of the proprietor of a vein, or bed, to extract
and remove his ore therefrom, should the same
be found to penetrate or intersect the premises
hereby granted, as provided by law; and there
is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a
right of way thereon for ditches, or canals
constructed by the authority of the United States.

In testimony whereof I, Grover Cleveland
President of the United States of America, have
caused these letters to be made Patent, and the
seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto
affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Wash-
ington, the fifth day of February, in the year
of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and
ninety four, and of the Independence of the
United States, the one hundred and eighteenth
