

United States to Leonard G. Higgins

Certificate 4410

To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas Leonard G. Higgins, of Skamania County Washington has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Leonard G. Higgins, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for "the lot numbered five of Section six in Township two north of Range five East of Willamette Meridian in Washington containing forty five acres and twenty one hundredths of an acre," according to the official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Leonard G. Higgins.

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Leonard G. Higgins and to his heirs, the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Leonard G. Higgins and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any valid and accrued waterrights for mining, agriculture, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such waterrights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same happen to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way otherwise for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
