To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:  
 Whereas Sam Samson of Skamania County  
 Washington, has deposited in the General Land Office  
 of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the  
 Land Office at Vancouver, Washington, whereby it ap-  
 pears that full payment has been made by the said  
 Sam Samson according to the provisions of the  
 act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled  
 An act making further provisions for the sale of  
 the public lands, and the acts supplemental thereto  
 for

The North West quarter of the North East quarter  
 of Section Ten in Township Three North of Range  
 Nine East of Willamette Meridian in Washington  
 containing forty acres

according to the official plat of the Survey  
 of the said lands, returned to the General Land  
 Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract  
 has been purchased by the said Sam Samson


Now know ye, that the United States of  
 America, in consideration of the premises, and  
 in conformity with the several acts of Congress  
 in such case made and provided, have given  
 and granted, and by these presents, do give and  
 grant unto the said Sam Samson and to his  
 heirs, the said tract above described: To have and  
 to hold the same, together with all the rights, priv-  
 ileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever  
 nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Sam  
 Samson, and to his heirs and assigns forever  
 subject to any vested and accrued water rights  
 for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other  
 purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs  
 used in connection with such water rights as  
 may be recognized and acknowledged by the

local customs, laws, and decisions of Courts and also subject to the right of the Proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the Authority of the United States

In Testimony whereof I, Grover Cleveland, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the fifth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ninety four, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and eighteenth.
