

Agreement between parties in Page 71-
 This agreement made and
 entered into this 20th day of August
 1894. by and between W. E. Evans
 S. T. Moore, Jackson Crouch, J. P.
 Anderson, F. W. Hale, Frank Clarke.

Witnesseth: That we and each and
 every one of us hereby agree to give
 a good and sufficient Warranty deed
 to each other as soon as we can by
 law get a title to our several claims
 as follows. J. P. Anderson ^{by deed} to deed
 to S. T. Moore ^{the agreement} all the land the said
 Anderson ^{the agreement} claimed by the old lines
 and the said W. E. Evans is also to
 deed to S. T. Moore what land he the
 said Moore claimed by the old lines.

J. Jackson Crouch, agree to deed
 to S. T. Moore all lands he claimed by
 the old lines and which I am allow-
 ed to file on. J. S. T. Moore agree
 to deed to Jackson Crouch all lands
 which I may file on that he the
 said Crouch claimed by the Old
 lines. J. Frank Hale agree to deed
 to S. T. Moore all lands I may file
 on that he the said S. T. Moore claim-
 ed by reason of the old lines and J.
 S. T. Moore agree to deed to Frank Clarke
 all land which I may file on that
 he the said Clarke claimed by reason
 of what is called the old lines.
