Know all men that I E. C. Hardy, of the County of Skamania and Territory of Washington, for the consideration of One Thousand Dollars, to me paid do hereby sell, and convey, to Lewis Van Vleet, of the County of Clark, and Territory of Washington, all my right, title, and interest, in and to a certain toll road, now owned by me, lying and being in the County of Skamania and Territory of Washington, said road beginning at the East boundary of Clarke County, and intersecting the U. S. Military Road, on the Cascade Portage.

Together with all my right, title and interest, in and to the Charter, granted to me the said E. C. Hardy, by the Legislature of Washington Territory, at their term held in 1862 & 1863, under which said toll Road was built, together with all the amendments thereto.

Now the condition of the above obligation is such, that if the said E. C. Hardy, ^{shall} will and truly pay, to the said Lewis Van Vleet, the sum of one Thousand Dollars, on, or before two years, from date hereof, then this obligation, shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
