 Whereas there has been deposited in the general Land Office of the United States a Certificate numbered, One Hundred and Fifty Two, of the Register and Receiver at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby it appears that under the provisions of the act of Congress, approved the 27th day of September 1850, entitled an act to create the Office of Surveyor General of Public Lands in Oregon, and to provide for the survey and to make donations to settlers of the said Public Lands, and the legislation supplemental thereto the claim of Daniel Baughman, and his wife Elizabeth Baughman of Skamania County County, Washington Territory, Notification No 368 has been established to a donation of one half section, or Three Hundred and twenty acres of Land, and that the same has been surveyed and designated as claim Number Forty Two, being parts of sections One, Two, and Eleven, in Township two, North of Range Seven East, according to the official plat of Survey, returned to the general Land Office by the Surveyor General being bounded, and described as follows,- to wit - Beginning at a point Sixteen chains west of the meander post at the North East corner of said Section Two and running thence north Fifty Six Chains and twelve links, Thence East Seventy Six chains, and fifty links, Thence South Six chains and Sixty three links, Thence North Seventy Seven degrees and thirty minutes, West two chains Sixty Five links, Thence South Fifty Seven degrees, West two chains Thence South Two chains, and ten links, Thence South Twenty degrees, and Thirty minutes, West three chains, and Seventy three links, Thence South One chain, and Eighty Seven links. Thence South, Twenty Five degrees, and Thirty minutes, East Two chains, and Seventy three links Thence South twenty nine degrees, West Four chains and Fifty links, Thence South Seventy Seven degrees and Forty Five minutes, West three chains and fifty links. Thence South Forty three degrees, and fifteen minutes, Three chains, and Seventy two links, Thence South, Sixty
