To have and to hold the above granted premises, with the privileges and appurtenances, thereunto belonging to the said Lewis Marr, his heirs, and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever, and we the said Samuel M Hamilton, and Mary J. Hamilton for ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators do covenant with the said Lewis Marr, his heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the above granted premises.
