From Fred Wilson

to

Charles R. Wilson.

This indenture made the (6th)Sixth day of November, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand, Eight Hundred, and Seventy Two, between Capt Fred Wilson of Multnomah County, State of Oregon, party of the first part, and Charles R. Wilson of the same County, and State, party of the second part. Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for, and in consideration of, the sum of Three Hundred, and Seventy Five Dollars, lawful coin money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised released, conveyed, and confirmed, and by these presents does grant, bargain sell alien, remise, release, convey, and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs, and assigns forever, all those certain tracts, lots, and parcels of land, lying, and being situate in Skamania County Washington Territory, and more particularly described as follows on the Maps and Plates of the United States Land Office, as the North East Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section No Six (6) in Township No (1) One, North of Range (6) Six East, Containing Forty Acres of Land, it being the same tract of land paid for by James E. Totten, to the receiver of the United States, Land Office at Vancouver, and also that other tract and parcel of land, situate in said County of Skamania, and known, and described as the West Half, of the North East Quarter, and Lots Nos One (1) and Two (2) of Section No Six (6) in Township No One (1) North of Range No Six (6) East containing, One Hundred, Fifty One Acres, it being the same tract of land formerly preempted by Robert McClure, both tracts of land containing One Hundred and Ninety One Acres of Land.

Together, with all, and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining and the reversion, and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues, and profits thereof, and also all estate, right, title interest, property, possession, claim, and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity of the said party of the first part, of, in, or to, the said premises, and every part thereof with the appurtenances,

To have and to hold, all and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs, and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part, and his heirs, the said premises, in the quiet, and peaceable possession of the said party of the second
