Laggers Lien.

Notice is Hereby Given, That
Harry Lamont, of Skamania County,
Washington, claims a lien upon a lot
of fir Saw-logs, being about 42,000 feet
in quantity, which were cut in Sko-
mania County, State of Washington,
and are unmarked, and are now
lying in a certain lake known as
Lang's lake, the same being in Section
13, Township 3, North of Range 8 East of
the Willamette Meridian, also on a
certain lot of ^{assorted} lumber composed of
boards, planks, scantings, etc., now ly-
ing at a certain mill, known as the
Rowe mill, the same being in the
aforesaid Section, Township and
Range, in Skamania County, State
of Washington, for labor performed
upon and assistance rendered in se-
curing and obtaining said logs and
lumber, as transfer in hauling said
logs.

That the name of the owners
or reputed owners is the Rowe Lum-
ber and Manufacturing Company (a cor-
poration).

That said Rowe Lumber and

Manufacturing Company by F. H. Rowe its managing agent, employed said Henry Lamont to perform such labor and render such assistance, upon the following terms and conditions to-wit:

The said Rowe Lumber and Manufacturing Company (a corporation), by and through F. H. Rowe, its managing agent, agreed to pay said Henry Lamont for such labor and assistance One Dollar per day and board and lodging for forty (40) days work during July, August and September 1896.

That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Henry Lamont, who performed labor upon and assisted in securing and obtaining said logs and lumber for the period of Forty days.

That said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs and lumber between the 30th day of July 1896. and the 27th day of September 1896. and the rendition of said services was closed on the 27th day of September 1896. and thirty days have not elapsed since that time. That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is

Party $(\$40\frac{00}{100})$ Dollars, that
no part thereof has been paid, except
Four $\frac{00}{100}$ $(\$4\frac{00}{100})$ Dollars and there is
now due and remaining unpaid
thereon, after deducting all just
credits and offsets, the sum of
Thirty-Five $\frac{00}{100}$ $(\$35\frac{00}{100})$ Dollars, in
which amount he claims a lien
upon said logs and lumber.

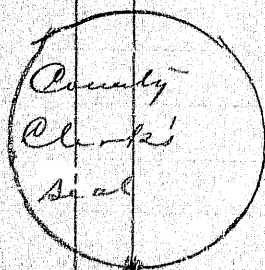
