

The Washougal Land Logging Co. and others to Brenner Bilgen

^{The Washougal Land and Logging Company (a corporation),}
^{the Portland Savings Bank, and O. N. Denney,}
^{as receiver of the Portland Savings Bank.}
 choice is hereby given that Brenner Bilgen, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of fir sawlogs for lumber, being about 2,200,000 feet in quantity, and a lot of hemlock logs for pulp, being about 500,000 feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, the fir logs being marked "B" on end and "WW" on side, and hemlock logs thus "H" on end and "VI" on side of each log, and said fir and hemlock logs are now lying in the Washougal River, in that part of said river lying and being in township number two, north of range five east of the Willamette Meridian, in said Skamania County, being between the Washougal Land and Logging Company's dam in said river and the chute therein and in and near said dam, and in said river as aforesaid, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in obtaining and securing said sawlogs and logs and greasing skids over which same were hauled and in marking said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is the Washougal Land and Logging Company, (a corporation); that the Portland Savings Bank, and O. N. Denney as Receiver of the Portland Savings Bank, of Portland, Oregon, have or claim to have some interest therein; that the said Washougal Land and Logging Company, by its duly authorized and constituted president, agent and manager, J. B. Buckley, employed said Brenner Bilgen to

perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions to-wit:

The said Washougal Land and Logging Company, by its said president, manager and agent, J. C. Buckley, agreed to pay the said Brenner Bilgen for such labor and assistance the sum of \$30.00 per month and furnish board and lodging free of charge, that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Brenner Bilgen, who performed labor upon said sawlogs and logs as a freeman for the period of 94 days, that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs and logs between the 11th day of May, 1895 and the 20th day of September, 1895, and the rendition of said service was closed on the evening of the 19th day of September 1895 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time, that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$108.10, that no part thereof has been paid except \$38.65, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$69.45, in which amount the claimant has a lien upon said sawlogs and logs. The said Brenner Bilgen also claims a lien upon all said sawlogs and logs now owned by said Washougal Land and Logging Company of said County, the said Portland Savings Bank, and the said O. W. Denny as Receiver of said Portland Savings Bank, and each of them, to secure

Payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said saw logs and logs herein described

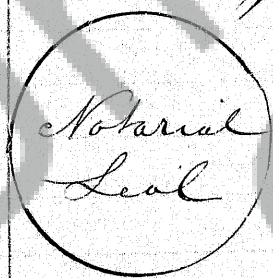
