value thereof.

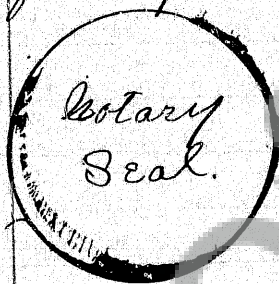
