To all to Whom these Presents shall Come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington, has been deposited in the General Land Office whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress Approved 20th May, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Blaudie B. Aircsman has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the East half of the Northwest Quarter and the Southwest quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Seventeen in Township Three North of Range Ten East of the Willamette Meridian, Washington, containing one hundred twenty acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

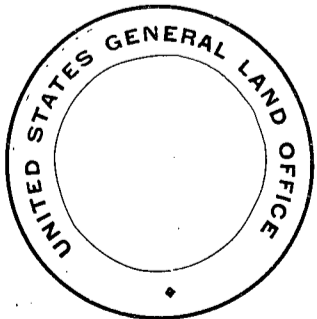
NOW, KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said claimant the tract of land above described:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns, forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode, to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, William H. Taft, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
