

Loggers Lien of Wm Palmer

William L. Palmer

Claimant

vs

The Washougal Land & Logging Company
(a Corporation), The Portland Savings
Bank, and O. N. Denny as receiver
of the Portland Savings Bank

Notice is hereby given
that William L. Palmer, of Skamania County,
State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot
of fir saw-logs, being about 2,200,000 feet in
quantity, and a lot of hemlock logs, being about
500,000 feet in quantity, which were cut or
manufactured in Skamania County, State
of Washington, the fir logs being marked thus
"S" on end and "W W" on side and the hemlock
logs thus "H" on end and "V I" on side of each log,
and said fir and hemlock logs are now lying
in the Washougal River, in that part of said
river lying and being in Township number
two, North of range five east of the Willa-
metto meridian in said Skamania County, being
between the Washougal Land and Logging Com-
pany's dam in said river and the chute therein,
and in said river as aforesaid and scattered
along in the woods near the banks of said river,
for labor performed upon and assistance render-
ed in building skid-road over which said logs
were hauled to the chute and barking, securing
and obtaining said saw-logs and logs, that
the name of the owner or reputed owner is
the Washougal Land and Logging Company
(a corporation); that the Portland Savings Bank
and O. N. Denny as Receiver of the Portland
Savings Bank, have or claim to have, some
interest therein; that the Washougal Land

and Logging Company, by its duly authorized and constituted president, manager and agent, J. A. Buckley, employed said William L. Palmer to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Washougal Land and Logging Company, by its said duly authorized and constituted president, manager and agent, J. A. Buckley, agreed to pay the said William L. Palmer for such labor and assistance the sum of \$26.00 per month, and furnish board and lodging free of charge; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said William L. Palmer, who performed labor upon and assisted in building steel road for said logs, and in bucking, securing and obtaining said saw logs and logs for the period of 13 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said saw logs and logs for the period of 13 days that said labor and assistance between the 25th day of August, 1895, and the 10th day of September, 1895, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 9th day of September, 1895, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$13.00; that no part thereof has been paid except \$1.00, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$12.00, in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs and logs. The said

William L Palmer also claims a lien on all said saw-logs and logs now owned by said Washington Land and Logging Company of said County, the said Portland Savings Bank, and the said O. C. Senny as Receiver of the said Portland Savings Bank, and each of them, to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said saw-logs and logs herein described.

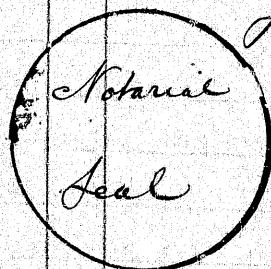
