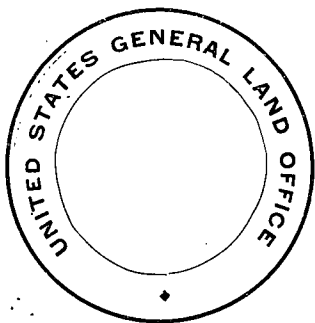

To all to Whom these Presents shall Come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, Simon Gile of Okanania County Washington Territory

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a

Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouverwhereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Simon Gileaccording to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the Sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North West quarter of the NorthWest quarter and Lot Numbered Eight of Section one, in Township
two North of Range Seven East, in the district of Lands subject to sale
at Vancouver Washington Territory, Containing Forty six acres, and
twenty two hundredths of an acreaccording to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Simon GileNOW, KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Simon Gile and to his heirs, the said tract above described:TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Simon Gileand to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode, to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the Twentieth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and Ninety Fourth.By the President: U.
