

Loggers Lien of Walter Duggan

Walter Duggan, claimant,

vs

The Washougal Land and Logging Company (a corporation)
The Portland Savings Bank, and
O. N. Denny as Receiver of the Portland Savings Bank

Notice is hereby given that Walter Duggan, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of fir saw-logs, being about 2,200,000 feet in quantity, and a lot of hemlock logs, being about 500,000 feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, the fir logs being marked thus "S" on end and "WW" on side and the hemlock logs thus "H" on end and "VI" on side of each log, and said fir and hemlock logs are now lying in the Washougal River, in that reach of the said river lying and being in Township number two, north of range five east of the Willamette meridian, in said Skamania County, being between the Washougal Land and Logging Company's dam in said river as aforesaid and scattered in the woods along and near the bank of said river, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling said saw-logs from the woods to the chute and river, and as teamster in logging camp, and in hauling skid-grease and rigging and in securing said saw-logs and logs, that the name of the owner or reputed owner is the Washougal Land and Logging Company (a corporation) that the Portland Savings Bank, and O. N. Denny as Receiver of the Portland Savings Bank, of Portland, Oregon, have or claim to have, some interest therein, that the said Washougal Land and Logging Company, by its duly authorized and constituted president, manager and agent, J. A. Buckley, employed said Walter Duggan to perform such lien and render

such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Washougal Land and Logging Company, by its said duly authorized and constituted president, manager and agent, J. A. Buckley, agreed to pay the said Walter Buggan for such labor and assistance the sum of \$60⁰⁰ per month as teamster in hauling logs from the woods to the chute, the sum of \$3⁰⁰ per day as teamster in logging camp hauling supplies, skid-grease and rigging, and \$4⁵⁰ per day for team used in hauling tools and supplies to camp and furnish board and lodging free of charge; that the said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Walter Buggan, who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling said logs from the woods to the chute, and as teamster in the logging camp in hauling supplies and rigging, and securing said saw-logs and logs for the period of 114½ days, viz: 83½ days in hauling logs from woods to the chute and 31 days as teamster in logging camp; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said saw-log and logs between the 28th day of April, 1895, and the 18th day of September, 1895; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 17th day of September, 1895, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$439²⁰ (\$192⁴⁵ as teamster in hauling logs from the woods to the chute, \$93⁰⁰ as teamster in logging camp, and \$153⁷⁵ for team used in hauling supplies, tools, skid-grease and rigging, amounting as aforesaid to \$439²⁰; that no part thereof has been paid except \$110⁸⁵ and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets,

the sum of \$328³⁵ in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw-logs and logs. The said Walter Suggan also claims a lien on all said saw-logs and logs now owned by said Washougl Land and Logging Company of said county, the said Portland Savings Bank, and the said A. H. Denny as Receiver of the said Portland Savings Bank, and each of them, to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said saw-logs and logs herein described

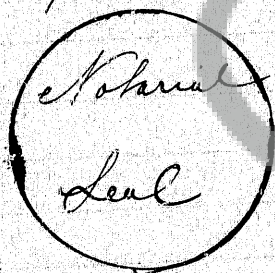
