Mining Law and the regulations of St. Helens Mining District, I located the northeast Discovery claim of the Black Rock Side Klamath County, State of Washington locality on Empire Creek, north Bottle Valley about 400 feet higher than the White fuzzy side claims where the creek makes a sharp bend to the west, beside a black rock in the creek bed.
