

Location of the Piney Mine Notice of Location

To whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given that B. Brunner a citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty-one years having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof and the State of Washington and the local customs laws rules and regulations of miners did on the 27th day of Aug. A.D. 1896 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Piney Lode or Mining claim said claim having been discovered the 27th day of August 1896 and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips spurs and angles and other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Copper Creek Mining District County of Klamath State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to wit:
