Notice of Location

To whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given that H. J. Cutting a citizen of the U.S. of America over the age of twenty one years having complied with the requirements of Chapter LXX of Title thirty two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof and the State of Wash and the local customs laws rules and regulations of miners did on the 18 day of Sep AD. 1896 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Yellow Hammer Lode or Mining claim said claim having been discovered the 18th day of Sep 1896 and to claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing immediately place by six hundred feet in width the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips spurs and angles and other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Copper Creek Mining District or Canyon Creek Corridor of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to wit: Commencing at the North west end of the claim known as the Yellow Hammer running (300) ft east and then (1500) North thence (600) ft West then (1500) South thence (300) East to place of beginning

and I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of America
