Notice is hereby given that Albert Moe of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and all real and personal property of C. B. Williams, which is used in the operation of his said saw mill, lumber and timber business, in Skamania County, Washington, to the extent of the money due him, from said C. B. Williams, operating said franchise or business, for labor performed in and about said C. B. Williams' saw mill as hereinafter set forth.

That the said property of the said C. B. Williams upon which the claimant herein claims a lien is situated as follows to-wit: Upon a certain wooden building — feet by — feet in size, situated on the North west quarter of Section thirty five, Township three North, Range seven East, Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, Washington, and used as a saw mill building by the said C. B. Williams; also upon the steam boiler and engines, saw mill machinery, pulleys, belting, shafts, saw chains, tools and any and all machinery and tools connected with or in any manner used in and about the said saw mill building, so situated as aforesaid; also upon any and all lumber, timber or ties of whatever nature or description now lying and being in the mill yard of said saw mill.

This lien is claimed for work and labor performed and assistance rendered by the claimant for the said C. B. Williams, as general work, in the operation of said saw mill, lumber and timber business, in Skamania County, Washington.

That the name of the owner or reputed owner is C. B. Williams, and Thomas Connell has or claims to have some interest or owner therein.

That said C. B. Williams, by F. B. Clark, his agent and manager, employed said Albert Moe, to perform such labor and render such assistance on the follow-

terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the said C. B. Williams, by and through F. B. Black, his agent and manager, agreed to pay said Albert Moe, for such labor and assistance the sum of \$2⁰⁰ per day for all work and labor performed.

That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Albert Moe, who performed labor in and about said sawmill for the period of 27 ¹/₄ days.

That said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered in said sawmill between the 25th day of April, 1900, and the 30 day of May, 1900, and the rendition of said services were closed on the 30 day of May, 1900, and nine ¹/₂ days have not elapsed since that time. That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is Fifty-four ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ (\$54.50) Dollars.

That no part thereof has been paid, excepting "only eight (\$8.) Dollars, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of Twenty Six ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ (\$26.50 Dollars, in which amount the claimant herein claims a lien upon the property of the said C. B. Williams hereinbefore fully described.
