

Location of the "Old Standard" Mine

Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given to all whom it may concern that the undersigned B. W. Mattack a native born citizen of the United States over the age of twenty-one years has this day located under the Revised Statutes of the U. S. (Chapter 6 Title 32) a quartz claim of 1500 linear feet on this vein or lode running in a northwesterly direction from this notice and 300 feet on either side of center of ledge along said ledge for 500 feet including all dips, spurs, variations and angles, and all deposits of mineral included in said description with all water rights appertaining to said land for the purpose of development of said claim being situated in Skamania County, Bald Mountain Mining District State of Washington and more particularly described as follows to wit Commencing at the post where this notice is posted and thence running in a northwesterly direction along this lead for 500 feet to post marked center post on N. W. end of old Standard claim thence 300 feet in a Southwesterly direction to post marked S. W. cor of old Standard claim thence 500 feet in S. Easterly direction to post marked S. E. corner of old Standard claim thence 300 feet in a N. Easterly direction to this notice or place of beginning thence 300 feet in a North Easterly direction to post marked N. E. Cor of old Standard claim thence 500 feet in a N. Westerly direction to post marked N. W. corner of old Standard claim thence 300 feet in a S. Westerly direction of center post on N. W. end of said claim said claim being more particularly described as follows to wit about 3/8 of a mile up a small tributary of the main Naches River emptying into said river in the Big Pige on the West side and about 1 1/2 mile above the mouth of Blue Bird Creek in Bald Mountain Mining District Skamania Co.
