Notice of Location of Quartz Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the United States over the age of twenty one years on the 26th day of Aug 1895 discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or sandrock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead within the limits of the claim hereby located and have this 14th day of May 1896 under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode situated in the Mining District County of Klamath and State of Washington and known as the Uicon Mining claim and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to wit: This claim is located South East End of the Wonder Mining claim also corner the Blue Jacket on South East corner State this claim starts North Center State of Wonder Mine & runs 300 feet Nor Easterly to corner State thence 1500 feet South Easterly course to corner State thence 300 feet in South Westerly to center end State thence 300 feet South Westerly to corner state thence 300 feet South Westerly to corner state thence 1500 feet in North Westerly course to corner state thence 300 feet north Easterly course place of beginning this claim holds all dips spurs angles and valuable deposits and that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States Discovered on the ground.
