Notice is hereby given that C. C. Cooper, of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of cross-ties being about 600 in quantity which were cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus, abstract "X" on each log and are now lying near Collins Landing in the woods, in said County, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in making said cross-ties as follows: For peeling 210 cross ties and for puling 400 cross ties, and for marking off said cross-ties - which were left uncurved in the stacks; that the owner of the same or reputed owner is J. T. Peters who resides on the Dalles, State of Oregon; that W. E. George, Agent for said J. T. Peters employed said C. C. Cooper to perform such labor and render such assistance, upon the following terms and conditions to-wit: - The said W. E. George Agent for said Peters agreed to pay the said C. C. Cooper for such labor and assistance the sum of four (4) cents per each tie in length for peeling the same, and the further sum of One and one half (1 1/2) cents per tie for each tie in length for puling the same; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said C. C. Cooper, who performed labor upon and assisted in making said cross-ties for the period of 12 1/4 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said cross-ties between the 11th day of May A. D. 1898 and the 25th day of May A. D. 1898, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 25th of May A. D. 1898 and thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said service is Fourteen (14) dollars; that no part thereof

been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$14.00, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs, together with his costs and a reasonable attorney's fee incurred in this action.

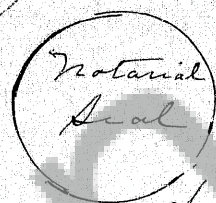
