WHEREAS, THERE HAS BEEN DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE OF THE UNITED STATES A CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE AT VANCOUVER, WASHINGTON, WHEREBY IT APPEARS THAT, PURSUANT TO THE ACT OF CONGRESS APPROVED 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of the Heirs of Ella M. Strunk Deceased formerly Ella M. McNutt has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to Law, for the North half of the Northeast quarter and the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section Nine in Township One North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian in Washington containing One Hundred and Twenty acres.

ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF SAID LAND, RETURNED TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE BY THE SURVEYOR GENERAL.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAID TRACT OF LAND WITH THE APPURTENANCES THEREOF, UNTO THE SAID HEIRS OF ELLA M. STRUNK, DECEASED AND TO THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER; SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING, AGRICULTURAL, MANUFACTURING, OR OTHER PURPOSES, AND RIGHTS TO DUTCHES AND RESERVOIRS USED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS AS MAY BE RECOGNIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE LOCAL CUSTOMS, LAWS, AND DECISSIONS OF COURTS, AND ALSO SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF THE PROPRIETOR OF A VEIN OR LODE TO EXTRACT AND REMOVE HIS ORE THEREFROM, SHOULD THE SAME BE FOUND TO PENETRATE OR INTERSECT THE PREMISES HEREBY GRANTED, AS PROVIDED BY LAW, AND THERE IS RESERVED FROM THE LANDS HEREBY GRANTED, A RIGHT OF WAY THEREON FOR DITCHES, OR CANALS CONSTRUCTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED STATES.

WHEREAS, A CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE AT VANCOUVER, WASHINGTON, HAS BEEN DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE, WHEREBY IT APPEARS THAT, PURSUANT TO THE ACT OF CONGRESS OF MAY 20, 1862, "TO SECURE HOMESTEADS TO ACTUAL. SETTLERS ON THE PUBLIC DOMAIN," AND THE ACTS SUPPLEMENTAL THERETO, THE CLAIM OF JENNIE MURPHY HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED AND DULY CONSUMATED, IN CONFORMITY TO LAW, FOR THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION NINE IN TOWNSHIP TWO NORTH OF RANGE SIX EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, WASHINGTON, CONTAINING FORTY ACRES,

FOREVER; SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING, AGRICULTURAL,
MANUFACTURING, OR OTHER PURPOSES, AND RIGHTS TO DITCHES AND RESURVOIRS USED IN
CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS, AS MAY BE RECOGNIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE
LOCAL CUSTOMS. LAWS, AND DECISIONS OF COURTS; AND THERE IS RESERVED FROM THE LANDS
HEREBY GRANTED A RIGHT OF WAY THEREON FOR DITCHES OR CANALS CONSTRUCTED BY THE
AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED STATES.
