Notice of Location

To whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned a citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statute of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of mining, did on the 10th day of September A.D. 1896 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim known as the old Bell Lode or Mining claim said claim having been discovered and discovered the 10th day of September 1896 and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Cedar Creek Dist County of Preamble State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to wit:-

From discovery thence 25 feet to N. Easterly center
Stk thence 200 to Easterly cor Stk thence 800 to S Easterly
cor Stk thence 200 to S. Westerly Center Stk thence 200 S.
Westerly center Stk thence 200 S. Westerly cor Stk thence 800
to N. Westerly cor Stk thence 200 to N. Easterly center Stk

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of minor and mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington
