Isaiah Woods, Claimant,

Notice is hereby given that Isaiah Woods of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of fire cord wood being about 450 cords in quantity, which was cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus not marked and are now lying in the South East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section 24, Township Three North Range Seven East of the Will. Mer., 150 cords of said wood are now lying in Lots 5 and 8 in Section 26 Township Three North Range 7½ East of the Will. Mer. and also about 80 cords of said wood are now lying in or near the wharf on the Columbia River in Lot 13 in Section 26 Township Three North Range 7½ East of the Will. Mer. all in Skamania Co. Wash., for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling and fluming said cord wood: that the name of the owner or reputed owner is J. D. Crawford; that J. D. Crawford employed said Isaiah Wood to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

That said J. D. Crawford agreed to pay the said Isaiah Wood for such labor and assistance \$1.75 per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Isaiah Wood, who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling and fluming said cordwood, that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said cord wood between the 21st day of May, 1900, and the 10th day of June, 1900; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 10th day of June, 1900, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$31.00; that no part thereof has been paid except ——— and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$31.00, in which amount he claims a lien upon the said cord wood. The said Isaiah Wood also claims a lien on all said cord wood now owned by said J. D. Crawford of said county and State to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said cord wood herein described.
