

Location of the "Hanse Eggert" Mine

Notice of Location of a Lode Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty one years, on the 2 day of September 1896 discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or sand rock in place bearing Gold Silver and lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located and have this 5 day of September 1896, under and in accordance with the Revised Statute of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District, County of Kamama and State of Washington and known as the "Hanse Eggert" Mining claim and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from the notice at the discovery or prospect shaft the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural object or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to wit: Commencing at notice Running 300 feet North Easterly to South Easterly Corner post Thence 1500 feet North Westerly to North East corner post 300 feet South Westerly to Center End stake Thence 300 feet South Westerly to North West Corner Post Thence 1500 feet South Easterly to South West corner Post Thence 300 feet North Easterly to place of beginning this claim is situated about $1\frac{1}{2}$ mile from East Fork of Washington River and 300 feet south West from Silver Creek and that I intend to hold and work said claim as provided by the local laws, and the custom and rules of miners and mining statute and laws of the United States
