WHEREAS, A CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE AT VANCOUVER, WASHINGTON HAS BEEN DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE, WHEREBY IT APPEARS THAT, PURSUANT TO THE ACT OF CONGRESS OF MAY 20, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the Claim of Kattie Belle Wills, formerly Kattie Belle Hawley, has been extablished and Duly Consumated, in Conformity to Law, for the H. E. Survey No. 193, EMBRACING A PORTION OF, APPROXIMATELY, Section Thirty-one in Township Four North OF RANGE Eight East of the Willamette Meridian, Washington, more particularly BOUNDED AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT CORNER NO. 1, FROM WHICH THE SOUTHEAST CORNER TO SECTION THIRTY-SIX IN TOWNSHIP FOUR NORTH OF RANGE SEVEN AND ONE-HALF EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, BEARS NORTH THREE DEGREES ONE MINUTE EAST SEVEN AND EIGHTY-ONE-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS DISTANT; THENCE, NORTH THREE DEGREES ONE MINUTE EAST THREE AND FORTY-NINE-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS TO CORNER NO. 2; THENCE, NORTH SEVENTY-SIX DEGREES THIRTY-FIVE MINUTES EAST SEVEN AND EIGHTY-FOUR-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS TO CORNER NO. 3; THENCE, SOUTH SIXTY-ONE DEGREES NINE MINUTES EAST SEVEN AND FIFTY-CHAINS ONE-HUNDREDTHS/TO CORNER NO. 4; THENCE, SOUTH TWENTY-TWO DEGREES THIRTY-SEVEN MINUTES EAST ONE AND EIGHTY-SEVEN-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS TO CORNER NO. 5; THENCE, NORTH EIGHTY-NINE DEGREES FIFTY-FIVE MINUTES WEST FIFTEEN AND SEVEN-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS TO CORNER NO. 1, THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING FIVE AND SEVENTY-EIGHT-HUNDREDTHS ACRES.

ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF THE SAID LAND, RETURNED TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE BY THE SURVEYOR-GENERAL:

NOW KNOW YE, THAT THERE IS, THEREFORE, GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES UNTO THE SAID CLAIMANT THE TRACT OF LAND ABOVE DESCRIBED; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAID TRACT OF LAND, WITH THE APPURTENANCES THEREOF, UNTO THE SAID CLAIMANT AND TO THE HEIRS AND ASSIGNS OF THE SAID CLAIMANT FOREVER; SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING, AGRICULTURAL, MANUFACTURING, OR OTHER PURPOSES, AND RIGHTS TO DITCHES AND RESERVOIRS USED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS, AS MAY BE RECOGNIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE LOCAL CUSTOMS, LAWS, AND DECISIONS OF COURTS; AND THERE IS RESERVED FROM THE LANDS HEREBY GRANTED, A RIGHT OF WAY THEREON FOR DITCHES OR CANALS CONSTRUCTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED STATES.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I WOODROW WILSON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, HAVE CAUSED THESE LETTERS TO BE MADE PATENT, AND THE SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE TO BE HEREUNTO AFFIXED.
