WHEREAS, AN ORDER OF THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR HAS BEEN DEPOSITED
IN THE GENERAL LAND LNAO OFFICE, DIRECTING THAT A FEE SIMPLE PATENT ISSUE TO THE
CLAIMANT JESSIE GRAY, FORMERLY JESSIE BERNIE, AN INDIAN OF THE YAKIMA RESERVA-
TION, FOR THE SOUTH HALF OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF T

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS MAURICE S. CADONAU OF SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON HAS DEPOSITED
IN THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE OF THE UNITED STATES A CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF
THE LAND OFFICE AT VANCOUVER, WASHINGTON WHEREBY IT APPEARS THAT FULL PAYMENT HAS
BEEN MADE BY THE SAID MAURICE S. CADONAU ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT
OF CONGRESS OF THE 24TH OF APRIL, 1820, ENTITLED, "AN ACT MAKING FURTHER PROVISION
FOR THE SALE OF THE PUBLIC LANDS," AND THE ACTS SUPPLEMENTAL THERETO, FOR THE
LOTS NUMBERED ONE, TWO AND THREE AND THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST
QUARTER OF SECTION THREE IN TOWNSHIP TWO NORTH OF RANGE SIX EAST OF WILLAMETTE
MERIDIAN IN WASHINGTON CONTAINING ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-THREE ACRES AND NINETY-
SEVEN HUNDREDTHS OF AN ACRE ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF THE
SAID LANDS, RETURNED TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE BY THE SURVEYOR GENERAL, WHICH
SAID TRACT HAS BEEN PURCHASED BY THE SAID MAURICE S. CADONAU

NOW KNOW YE, THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE
PREMISES, AND IN CONFORMITY WITH THE SEVERAL ACTS OF CONGRESS IN SUCH CASE MADE
AND PROVIDED, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, AND BY THESE PRESENTS DO GIVE AND GRANT,
UNTO THE SAID MAURICE S. CADONAU AND TO HIS HEIRS, THE SAID TRACT ABOVE DESCRIBED;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, TOGETHER WITH ALL THE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES,
IMMUNITIES, AND APPURTENANCES, OF WHATSOEVER NATURE, THEREUNTO BELONGING, UNTO THE
SAID MAURICE S. CADONAU AND TO HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER; SUBJECT TO ANY
VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING, AGRICULTURAL, MANUFACTURING, OR OTHER

PURPOSES, AND RIGHTS TO DITCHES AND RESERVOIRS USED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS, AS MAY BE RECOGNIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE LOCAL CUSTOMS, LAWS, AND DECISIONS OF COURTS, AND ALSO SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF THE PROPRIETOR OF A VEIN OR LODE TO EXTRACT AND REMOVE HIS ORE THEREFROM, SHOULD THE SAME BE FOUND TO PENETRATE OR INTERSECT THE PREMISES HEREBY GRANTED, AS PROVIDED BY LAW; AND THERE IS RESERVED FROM THE LANDS HEREBY GRANTED, A RIGHT OF WAY THEREON FOR DITCHES OR CANALS CONSTRUCTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED STATES.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I, THEODORE ROOSEVELT, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, HAVE CAUSED THESE LETTERS TO BE MADE PATENT, AND THE SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE TO BE HEREUNTO AFFIXED.

GIVEN UNDER MY HAND, AT THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, THE FIFTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE, AND OF THE INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-EIGHTH

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, A CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE AT VANCOUVER, WASHINGTON, HAS BEEN DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE, WHEREBY IT APPEARS THAT, PURSUANT TO THE ACT OF CONGRESS OF MAY 20, 1862, "TO SECURE HOMESTEADS TO ACTUAL SETTLERS ON THE PUBLIC DOMAIN," AND THE ACTS SUPPLEMENTAL THERETO, THE CLAIM OF JOSEPH C. REIS HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED AND DULY CONSUMATED IN CONFORMITY TO LAW, FOR THE H. E. SURVEY NO. 234, EMBRACING A PORTION OF, APPROXIMATELY, SECTION THIRTY-FIVE IN TOWNSHIP FIVE NORTH OF RANGE NINE EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, WASHINGTON, MORE PARTICULARLY BOUNDED AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT CORNER NO. 1, FROM WHICH THE STANDARD QUARTER CORNER TO SAID SECTION THIRTY-FIVE BEARS SOUTH EIGHTY-NINE DEGREES TWELVE MINUTES EAST ONE AND EIGHTY-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS DISTANT; THENCE NORTH EIGHTY-NINE DEGREES TWELVE MINUTES WEST NINE AND SIXTY-TWO-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS TO CORNER NO. 2; THENCE NORTH THIRTY DEGREES SEVEN MINUTES WEST EIGHTEEN AND NINETY-FOUR-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS TO CORNER NO. 3; THENCE NORTH EIGHTY-NINE DEGREES THIRTY-SIX MINUTES EAST NINE AND EIGHTY-SIX-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS TO CORNER NO. 4; THENCE SOUTH TWENTY-NINE DEGREES ELEVEN MINUTES EAST EIGHTEEN AND NINETY-EIGHT-HUNDREDTHS CHAINS TO CORNER NO. 1, THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING SIXTEEN AND THREE-HUNDREDTHS ACRES, ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF THE SAID LAND, RETURNED TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE BY THE SURVEYOR-GENERAL:

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
